Special Meeting via Zoom /September 3, 2020/ 6pm

The meeting was called to order at 6:10

M/M, Thompson/Flanagan to amend the agenda to move Spring Soccer Request to the first topic. All were in favor. Motion Carried.

Spring Soccer Request-Kevin Lafond, President of the Northwest Soccer Club, made a request to the Board to use the soccer fields at Veterans' Field for the spring 2021 season. A discussion was held regarding in part; user fees, field availability, maintenance, club tryouts vs. non tryouts. Mr. LaFond requested that the fees stipulated in our current policy be lowered. Thompson asked Mette to put together an estimate of the cost of the club's use of the fields and the discussion will continue at the next meeting.

Old Business: Triathlon Wrap Up-There was very positive feedback about the day from the participants. Board members felt that pre-registration made the check in process much quicker and more organized.

Beach Wrap Up-The docks will be removed from the water next week as well as the weed mats. The tree stumps will be ground and removed and the grass reseeded. The beach gate will be locked until the docks are out.

Fall Activities- Kickball for grades 3-5 will be postponed until October 1. The COVID situation will be assessed after schools are opened for a few weeks. The Audubon will partner with SP&R to offer an after school birding for grades 6-8. Also the Sharon Land Trust will offer opportunities for middle school students to work outdoors and learn about natural resources.
