Here are some waste management bullet points to keep in mind in case you are asked about the status of recycling, reusing, remanufacturing, repurposing, etc.

- Most valuable items in single stream: Aluminum and PET plastic (#2)
- Least valuable items in single stream: Glass, Mixed Paper (with the exception of OCC or corrugated cardboard, for which there is still a market though price has declined greatly)

- More MRFs and remanufacturing plants are under construction (most likely slowed down by Covid19)
- Things to think about:
 - PAYT or SMART (pay as you throw) proven to reduce MSW (municipal solid waste) and shown to be fairer to smaller households and those with more efficient recycling and organics diversion
